

STUDENT HEALTH CENTER FEE

MSJC has **Student Health & Wellness Centers** at each campus. These centers are being funded through a mandatory fee assessed to both full-time and part-time students of \$26 for the Fall and Spring semesters and \$22 for the Summer semester. The fee is assessed regardless of whether the student utilizes the available services or has their own insurance*.

ELIGIBILITY/SERVICES:

Student Health & Wellness Centers are available to all currently enrolled students who have paid the Student Health Fee (<https://catalog.msjc.edu/student-fees/enrollment-fees/#otherfeestext>). Our Student Health Center services (https://www.msjc.edu/healthcenter/General_Office_Hours.html) include quality health care in the form of:

- RN and/or Nurse Practitioner wellness, illness, and/or injury visits;
- Over-the-counter medication;
- Health education and wellness workshops;
- Immunizations and immunization reviews;
- COVID-19 and Influenza testing;
- Lab and diagnostic testing;
- Mental health counseling;
- Referrals to outside health agencies in the community, and so much more.

INJURIES ON CAMPUS:

Limited medical insurance is available against accidental injury while on campus. All college accidents involving students should be reported immediately to the Student Health Center for proper evaluation and treatment. Non-student related accidents should be reported immediately to Risk Management.

*STUDENT HEALTH CENTER FEE EXEMPTION WAIVER:

Students who are in a state approved apprenticeship training program depend exclusively on prayer for healing, in accordance with the teachings of a bona fide religious sect, denomination, or organization, and can supply the college with documentation of active membership, may submit a Health Center Fee Exemption Waiver along with supporting documentation to the Health Center office at any campus for approval. Exemptions are semester-based and must be submitted each semester prior to the full-term refund deadline (end of the 2nd week of Instruction).
